- 4. When cows walked across the bridge the troll shouted "go away," when sheep walked across the bridge the troll shouted "leave," and when goats walked across the bridge the troll shouted "shoo."
- 5. Neil's bridge was not blue or orange, Nigel's bridge was not blue, and Nancy's bridge was not green.
